My name is Beth Vickers, I am a Admin Apprentice at West Yorkshire Learning Providers, I am studying business administration and I am currently preparing to go through my end point assessment.

SO HOW IS IT GOING?

It's going really well considering the situation. I have enjoyed working from home, this was something new for me. I am also preparing to go through my EPA so just getting my portfolio up-to date.

WHAT IS YOUR CURRENT SITUATION? - HAVE YOU BEEN FURLOUGHED, STILL WORKING OR WORKING FROM HOME? I am currently working from home and have been for around 7 weeks

WHAT LEARNING ARE YOU DOING AS PART OF YOUR APPRENTICESHIP DURING THIS TIME?

Myself and my colleagues have been completing some online learning, and identifying some upskilling opportunities as I am waiting to go through EPA so I am currently revising for the multiple choice exam as well as keeping my off the job updated.
