Clinical Skills for Carers

This course is aimed at L2 and L3 practitioners who want to gain additional knowledge, skills and behaviours to support their development in the health and social care sector, this could be additional responsibilities or a higher-level role within the area of health and social care they currently work or employment within a different area of the health and social care sector.

Course Overview

The course will take place over 5 days with 1 day of online modules and 4 days classroom training covering knowledge, practical training and associated assessments.

You will learn clinical skills to benefit you within your role and the content of the course will change dependent on your need. On completion you will be able to provide higher level care and support to service users within the health and social care sector.

Available modules include:

Chronic heart failure, Chronic kidney disease, Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, Diabetes management including medication and monitoring, Epilepsy including buccal medication administration, Male and female catheterisation, Intramuscular injections, Intravenous drug administration, Oxygen and nebuliser therapy, PEG feeding, Stoma care, Suction, Syringe driver, Tracheostomy care, Venepuncture, Verification of expected death, Vital signs and Wound care.
