What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is when an individual works and learns at the same time.

As an apprentice, you will be working in a real job where you will be employed by a company, have a contract of employment, get paid a salary and be entitled to statutory benefits such as holiday and sick pay

What makes an apprenticeship different to other jobs?

What makes an apprenticeship different to another job is that you will also be working towards a recognised apprenticeship standard alongside your job. These standards will be directly relevant to the job that you are doing, whatever role you are working in.

What kind of apprenticeships are there?

There are apprenticeships available at Intermediate, Advanced, Higher and Degree ranging from level 2 to level 7. These cover more than 280 industries and 1500 job roles in sectors.

From Nursing to Graphic Design, Horticulture to Electric Vehicle Engineering, Advertising to Nuclear Decommissioning.

Most people think that apprenticeships are only available in a limited number of job roles and only in certain sectors like construction or retail. But that isn't true - there are literally thousands of jobs out there working in all sorts of different exciting organisations.

Which companies offer apprenticeships?

It could be that you end up working with a large company who you might have heard of before, or it could be that you end up working with a smaller business that you may not have heard of before.

Some small companies can have amazing opportunities for apprentices, you might get to work on some really innovative and creative projects, or even have the chance to travel overseas.

It's important you do your research and see what you can find out about the company before you start applying.

Do you get a job at the end of the apprenticeship?

Most apprentices do. A survey conducted by the National Apprenticeship Service showed that the majority of apprentices (90%) either stay employed with the employer that they have completed their apprenticeship with, or will go on to find another job with a different employer. Some apprentices decide at the end of their apprenticeship that they want to go on to further study, such as starting a full time degree at university or college.

How are apprenticeships delivered?

The way that apprenticeships are delivered will vary depending on the employer that you work for and the kind of job role you have as an apprentice. Some employers prefer to have their apprentices learning away from the work place for the first few weeks or months of the apprenticeship, others might prefer for you to go to a training provider for 1 day per week and others might prefer for you to learn 100% on-the-job. This next section explores these options in a bit more detail.

What is the difference between on-the-job and off-the-job training?

On-the-job and off-the-job training are phrases that are used a lot with apprenticeships. In summary, the main difference between the two are:

On-the-job this is where you learn in the workplace. You will be developing your skills by working with colleagues who will show you how to carry out certain tasks. This training could be formal (in a structured session) or informal (where it might be unplanned).

Off-the-job this is when you learn and develop your skills and knowledge away from your immediate place of work. It might be that you use a computer to access some on-line learning, or you might leave the workplace to attend a training centre where you will learn in a classroom or workshop with other apprentices.

#01 APPRENTICESHIPS

Anyone over 16 can complete an apprenticeship.

Some older professionals even use them to upskill in their current jobs.

MYTH

#02 APPRENTICES HAVE
TO SPEND A DAY PER
WEEK AT COLLEGE.

BUSTED!

Apprenticeships do include some 'off-the-job' training, however this can include shadowing employees and attending online training – it doesn't have to mean college!

MYTH

#03 APPRENTICESHIPS
ARE ONLY AVAILABLE
FOR 'MANUAL' JOBS.

BUSTED!

Apprenticeships are available in pretty much every sector: HR, law, recruitment, engineering and beauty, you name it!

MYTH

#04 APPRENTICESHIPS
ARE FOR PEOPLE
WHO DON'T DO
WELL AT SCHOOL.

BUSTED!

Apprenticeships are high quality pathways into employment, just like A Levels or Degrees. They allow you to earn while you learn and get real life experience and skills.

MYTH

#05 APPRENTICES DON'T
GET FAIR PAY.

BUSTED!

All apprentices are entitled to the national minimum apprenticeship wage, however a large number of business will pay above this rate. They also get holiday pay and other statutory employee rights.

UNIVERSITY DEGREES.

Apprentices develop a huge range of attractive, real-life skills. And with Degree Apprenticeships, you can get the best of both worlds!

How do you find an apprenticeship?

You can find apprenticeships using the Find An Apprenticeship website. To register just follow these 3 simple steps:

1. Create an account at:
www.gov.uk/apply-apprenticeship
2. Check your emails for your activation code
3. Use your activation code to verify your account

You can also contact your local careers service, training providers and colleges, follow companies on twitter, Facebook and LinkedIn as many will advertise through social media, or speak to family and friends.

When do you need to start applying for an apprenticeship?

Applying for an apprenticeship is very different to applying to 6th form, college or university.

The jobs are not all advertised on the one date and they do not all start in September. Jobs are advertised throughout the year on the Find An Apprenticeship website. You will need to check the website regularly to view the different jobs available.

What if I have already found a job?

If you already have an employer in place who has agreed to offer you an apprenticeship, they will need to find a training organisation to support you with the training element of your programme. Apprentice's Experience

Harrison Eccles, Joiner Apprentice, Reds10

"I've always been hands-on, I've always worked with tools and in the trades, so it was the way I went after school. I did my Level 1 at East Riding College and wanted to get out into the trade and do something with my hands.

I like to keep working, have money coming in, and set myself up for the future. An apprenticeship was the best route for me so I could hit both targets at the same time.

I'm always around the other guys and the team managers who show me what to do and set me off on work. It's here, there and everywhere; it's not just one job at one time. I'm doing a lot of plaster boarding, stud walling, flooring, shower units and all sorts.

I've always got a team manager to go to on a day-to-day basis if I ever need any questions answered. As I'm so new, I'm yet to go to college, but I'm sure there'll be a lot of support there for me too, as I progress through my apprenticeship.

If you want to get out there, earn some money and a qualification, I can't see why you wouldn't choose an apprenticeship."

"I did my GCSEs and A Levels in this country, and then I went to America for four years to do my degree. When I returned to the country, I was looking for a job and had a link with Reds10 through their partnership with Hull City Ladies Football Club, so I explored the roles they had.

My background is in sports management, so nothing to do with product quality. Reds10 offered me the apprenticeship route, and I thought it was a great opportunity to learn something new and gain new skills.

I work with the factory managers on the products that go to customers to make sure the quality's right. If there are issues, I can flag them and get them resolved to make sure we're producing high-quality products.

I'm really supported by everyone in the office and in the factory – they're all willing to help. If I have questions or things I don't know, I can ask other employees or factory managers, and they tell me how everything's put together and what it should look like when it's done right.

The advice I would give is to ask yourself what you can see yourself doing in the future. If you don't already have the skills, that's okay. Just look to see what apprenticeships are out there and build your skills while you're doing the job."
