The Link Training was founded on September 14th, 13 years ago, Amanda began with just five apprentices. Since then, it has evolved into one of the largest apprenticeship providers for hairdressing in the region. The levy learner initiative has propelled growth into business and team leadership. Currently, there are 160 learners and 20 industry staff members dedicated to hair leadership and coaching under direct contracts.

Learners have recently achieved exceptional results, with several attaining distinctions in their End-Point Assessments. This milestone highlights the dedication of both the learners and staff in delivering top-tier education and support.
