## **NEWS and UPDATES from member:**

Under the Forging Futures banner, the organisation boasts some impressive programmes and credentials, including:

- Construction Employability courses, where over 70% of students transition into employment.
- Real Site Skills, which supports individuals aged 19 and over in reskilling for construction areas and securing employment.
  - Green Skills Academy, where all participants learn key foundational principles related to a range of green skills methods and practices. These industry-led courses are major contributors to the delivery of net low carbon, energy-efficient homes, whether for new builds or retrofitting existing properties and housing stock. In delivering this education programme, the organisation employs a blended learning model that includes classroom sessions, lectures, and presentations. As they explore the future of the industry, they also incorporate the future of training by including Virtual Reality immersive modules, delivered by their partner Focus XR.

The Green Skills hub is a unique opportunity for Leeds residents to learn passive house techniques and skills for the future.

Forging Futures have joined forces with Juniper Training to provide study programme opportunities to 16-18-year-olds across Leeds - this programme is in its first year but is already being hailed a huge success, with long waitlists and excellent outcomes into industry and apprenticeships. The programme is small but growing and for the last intake of 12 there were over 100 applications for 20 places! The beauty of what Forging Futures does, is in their relationships with industry experts from across a range of disciplines that are willing and proud to provide training and teaching to young people and adults in order to develop the next generation of construction workforce for the city, with over 80% of adult learners accessing work - this is Education and Industry alignment at its best!
