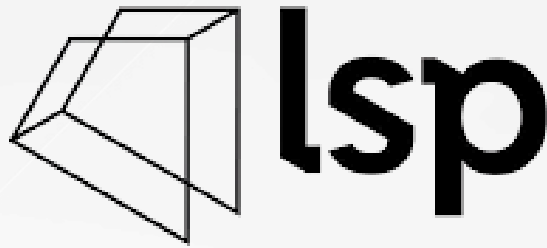


The First Avenue Training team walked 100 miles because 100 percent of us deserve better mental health

York College Mix offers students option to combine A Levels with a vocational subject from 2026/27

If students are unsure whether to choose A Levels or a vocational route after Year 11? From 2026, York College & University Centre will make that decision easier with the new York College Mix - allowing students to study two A Levels alongside one A-Level-equivalent AAQ.

AAQs offer practical, academic learning backed by employers and carry the same UCAS points as A Levels. Subjects will include Applied Science, Cyber Security & Networks, Early Childhood Development, Engineering, Enterprise & Innovation, Health, IT, Medical Science, Marketing, Policing & Criminal Justice, and Sport, Exercise & Health.

York College is also introducing Environmental Science A Level, expanding its A Level choice to 37 subjects - the widest in North Yorkshire.

More new programmes are coming, including three new T Levels (Marketing, Jewellery Maker, and Legal Services) and a Level 3 Creative Practice - Photography course. Eight new apprenticeships are already live, with more expected in 2026.

DN Colleges Group Smashes “Building Bridges” Campaign to Support Local Businesses and Young People

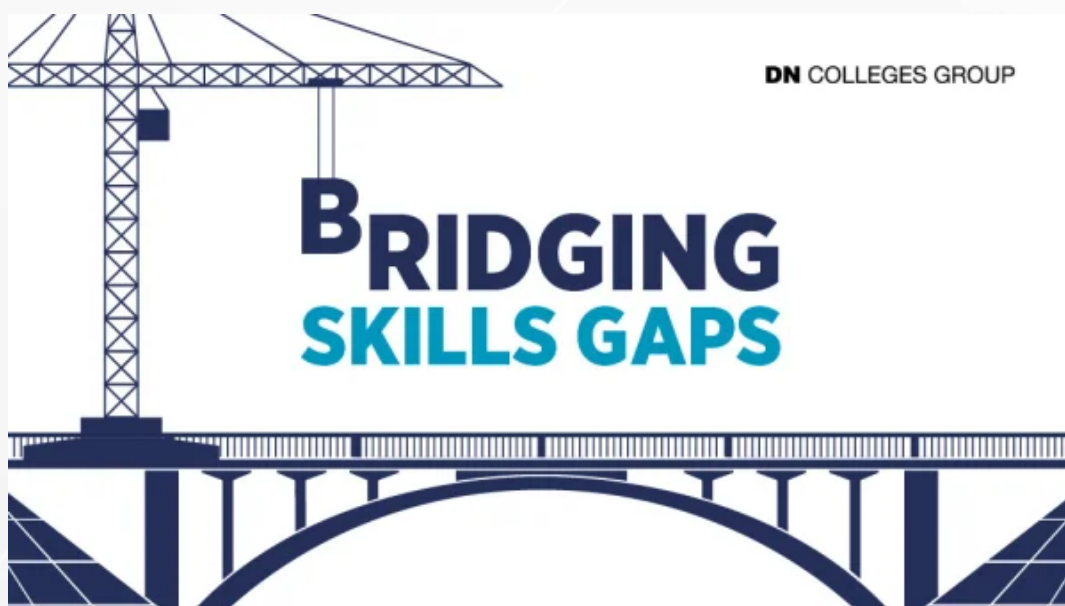
DN Colleges Group is celebrating the success of its Building Bridges campaign, which set out to create 100 new apprenticeship opportunities in 100 days – and delivered 147.
