- ***Access to information***

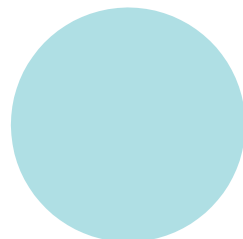
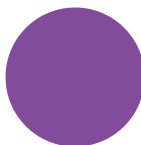

Membership Subscription

West Yorkshire Learning Providers (WYLP) is a membership based organisation to support members in the delivery of Apprenticeships, employment and skills.

WYLP operates at the strategic level with Government Agencies, stakeholders and partners across West Yorkshire and the Leeds City Region to ensure its members have a voice and are effectively represented at all levels.

WYLP can only retain its position and credibility and the interests of its members if they are prepared to continue to invest in the organisation and become proactive at the local network level.
